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(a) In the event of disability, death, absence or 2 3 other condition which prevents execution of the duties of 4 the adjutant general, and prior to an appointment of the 5 governor to the contrary, the duties of the adjutant general shall be executed by the following officers: senior 6 assistant adjutant general for either the army national 7 8 guard or air national guard, by date of rank, as is then 9 currently available. If none are available, then such 10 duties shall be executed by the senior general officer for 11 either the army national quard or air national guard, by 12 date of rank, as is then currently available.

19 combination with such elements of the army and air forces
20 of the national guard of the United States as are allocated
21 to the state by the president, the secretary of defense or
22 the secretary of army or air, and accepted by the state:

1 (ii) Two (2) Those assistant adjutants general 2 and general officers appointed pursuant to W.S. 3 19-7-104(a); 4 19-9-301. National guard officers generally. 5 6 (b) All officers appointed in the national guard of 7 8 Wyoming except the adjutant general, and assistant 9 adjutants general and additional general officers shall 10 hold their membership until they have reached seventy (70) 11 years of age unless retired or discharged prior to that time. No officer possesses a property interest in any duty 12 13 position. The adjutant general is the discharge authority for all officers except the adjutant general, for which the 14 15 governor shall be that authority. Any officer may be 16 discharged from the Wyoming national guard according to 17 procedures established by orders and regulations prescribed 18 or promulgated by the adjutant general or according to 19 federal law and regulation. An officer discharged from the 20 United States air force or army reserves or who has his 21 federal recognition withdrawn shall also be discharged from

the Wyoming national guard effective as of the date of

1 discharge from the reserves or withdrawal of federal

2 recognition.
