4 Section 2. There is appropriated two million two 5 hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$2,243,000.00) from the general fund to the supreme court. This appropriation 6 shall be for the period beginning with the effective date 7 of this act and ending June 30, 2014. This appropriation 8 9 shall only be expended for the purpose of implementing the 10 judicial salary increases authorized this by act. of 11 Notwithstanding any other provision law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 12 13 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated 14 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
