17 (a) After calculating earnings from the mineral trust fund attributable to the 2016 fiscal year as required by 2015 18 19 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 142, section 346, the first 20 thirty-seven million five hundred thousand dollars 21 (\$37,500,00.00) shall be deposited as provided in that section. The next twenty-four million two hundred thousand 22 dollars (\$24,200,000.00) of such calculated earnings shall be 23

deposited to a mineral impacted road account, which is hereby 1 2 Any remaining earnings shall be available for 3 appropriation as provided in section 346. To the extent that 4 less than twenty-four million two hundred thousand dollars (\$24,200,000.00) in fiscal year 2016 earnings is deposited to 5 the mineral impacted road account, monies from the highway 6 fund shall be used as necessary to provide a total of twenty-7 8 four million two hundred thousand dollars (\$24,200,000.00) for projects under this section. The department of transportation 9 10 shall submit an exception budget request to the governor for 11 inclusion in the 2019-2020 biennial budget requesting an 12 appropriation to the highway fund in an amount equal to any funds expended from that fund to meet the requirements of this 13 section, to the extent the funds have not been repaid from the 14 15 appropriation in section 7 of this section.
