Choice license plates for disabled veterans.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle license plates; expanding
2 the distinctive license plate options available for free to
3 disabled veterans; specifying fees; specifying application
4 procedures; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-215(b) and by creating new
9 subsection (e) is amended to read:

11 **31-2-215. Disabled veteran's license plates.**

13 (b) Application for license plates under ~~subsection~~
14 subsections (a) and (e) of this section shall be annually
15 made to the county treasurer as provided by this article,
16 except application shall be made not less than thirty (30)

1 days before the last day of the applicant's annual
2 registration month. Application forms shall be available at
3 all county treasurer's offices. The department may prepare
4 any special forms and issue any rules and regulations
5 necessary to carry out this section.

6
7 (e) In lieu of the disabled veterans plate described
8 in subsection (a) of this section, a veteran who qualifies
9 for a special license plate under this section may select
10 to receive any distinctive license plate authorized by this
11 chapter for which the veteran qualifies and which is
12 related to service in the military. Application for the
13 license plate selected shall be made pursuant to subsection
14 (b) of this section and may require verification by the
15 Wyoming veterans' commission as otherwise required by this
16 chapter. Unless otherwise provided by law, any veteran
17 applying for a license plate under this subsection shall be
18 responsible for payment of the registration fees prescribed
19 by W.S. 31-3-101 and no additional fee shall be charged.

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
