## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to state parks and cultural resources;
- 2 authorizing the acceptance of lands as specified; and
- 3 providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1.

- 9 (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (b) of
- 10 this section, the legislature authorizes the acceptance of
- 11 the following lands to be managed by the department of
- 12 state parks and historic sites upon final negotiation with
- 13 the appropriate parties:

- 15 (i) Portions of Township 26N Range 66W as
- 16 follows:

2	(A) SE¼ SW¼, SE¼, and SE¼ NE¼ of Section 4;
3	
4	(B) NW¼ SW¼, S½ NW¼, S½ NE¼, and Lots 1 and
5	2 of Section 3;

7	(C) All of Lots 2 and 3 south and west of
8	the oxbow of the North Platte River, N½ SW¼, Parcel 2 B288
9	P644, SW¼ SE¼, Lot 4 (SE¼ SE¼), Parcel 1 B288 P644 of
10	Section 2;
11	
12	(D) Lots 3 and 2 and lands south of the
13	North Platte River in SW¼ SE¼ of Section 1;
14	
15	(E) Lands north of the County Road in the
16	NE¼ NE¼ of Section 11; and
17	
18	(F) $N\frac{1}{2}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 2 of Section 12.
19	
20	(b) Portions of land owned by Wyoming military
21	department included in the description in subsection (a) of
22	this section shall be transferred to the department in, or
23	managed by agreement by, phases. A property survey and

24 certified legal description shall be completed prior to any

1 transfer or agreement. The first phase shall include lands

2 where there are no existing conditions precluding transfer.

3 Phase II lands shall include those areas which fall within

4 current surface danger zones (SE½ SW½ and S½ SE½ of Section

5 4, N½ NW¼ SW¼ of Section 2). Phase II lands shall be

6 transferred when surface danger zones have been fully

7 mitigated. The third phase shall include lands owned by

8 Wyoming military department (S½ N½ SW¼ of Section 2, Parcel

9 2 B288 P644, and lands west of the County Road in W½ SW¼

10 SE¼ of Section 2) which shall be managed by memorandum of

11 understanding describing appropriate access and

12 development. Portions of land owned by the Town of

13 Guernsey and State of Wyoming office of state lands and

14 investments included in the description in subsection (a)

15 of this section shall be managed under a memorandum of

16 understanding between the department and the owners.

18 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

21 Constitution.
