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9 **Section 1**. W.S. 35-11-406(p) and by creating a new

10 subsection (q) and 35-11-431(a)(vi) are amended to read:

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35-11-406. Application for permit; generally; denial;

1 The following objection procedure shall apply to (p) 2 applications for mining permits for coal: 3 4 (i) Any interested person has the right to file written objections to the application with the director 5 6 within thirty (30) days after the last publication of the notice required in subsection (j) of this section. The 7 8 director shall within five (5) business days forward any objection to the applicant and shall make objections 9 10 available to the public; 11 12 (ii) If an informal conference is requested by the applicant or objector, the director shall hold the informal 13 conference in the locality of the proposed operation within 14 15 thirty (30) days after the final date for filing objections 16 under paragraph (i) of this subsection unless a different period is stipulated to by the parties. The director shall 17 publish notice of the time, date and location of the informal 18 19 conference in a newspaper of general circulation in the 20 locality of the proposed operation at least two (2) weeks 21 before the date of the informal conference;

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1	(iii) The director shall render a decision on the
2	application within thirty (30) days after completion of the
3	notice period required in subsection (j) of this section if
4	no informal conference or hearing is requested. If an the
5	director holds an informal conference, is held, all parties
6	to the conference shall be furnished with a copy of the final
7	written decision of the director issuing or denying the permit
8	within sixty (60) days of the conference. The applicant or
9	objector may appeal the director's written decision after an
10	informal conference to the council. If a hearing is held,
11	the council shall issue findings of fact and a decision on
12	the application within sixty (60) days after the final
13	hearing: The director shall issue or deny the permit no
14	later than fifteen (15) days from receipt of any findings of
15	fact and decision of the environmental quality council.
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17	(iv) Any person who does not object as provided
18	under this subsection has no right of appeal.
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20	(q) The following objection procedure shall apply for
21	any other mining permit application:

1	(i) Any interested person has the right to file
2	written objections to the administrator within thirty (30)
3	days after the last publication of the notice required in
4	subsection (j) of this section. The administrator shall
5	within five (5) business days forward any objection to the
6	applicant and shall make objections available to the public;
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8	(ii) The administrator shall review all objections
9	and shall forward a report and recommendations on the
10	objections to the director. The director shall issue to the
11	applicant and to any objector a final written decision issuing
12	or denying the permit within thirty (30) days after the
13	deadline to file objections provided in paragraph (i) of this
14	subsection;
