Т	pain to an opioid naive patient for more than a fourteen (14)
2	day supply in a fourteen (14) day period. The board shall by
3	rule establish reasonable exceptions to this section, in
4	consultation with other professional licensing boards that
5	license practitioners, including exceptions for chronic pain,
6	cancer treatment, palliative care and other clinically
7	appropriate exceptions. As used in this subsection:
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9	(i) "Opioid" means an opiumlike compound that
10	binds to one (1) or more of the major opioid receptors in the
11	body;

13	(ii) "Opioid naive patient" means a patient who
14	has not had an active opioid prescription in the preceding
15	forty-five (45) day period.

17	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2019.
