1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Wildlife and Natural Resource Funding Act; providing for funding of 2 projects under that act; specifying large projects approved 3 for funding in 2016; requiring specified conservation 4 easements to include the state of Wyoming as a third party 5 beneficiary as specified; requiring certifications 6 regarding kickbacks and gifts; providing appropriations; 7 providing for reversion of funds; and providing for an 8 9 effective date.
