7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-17-124 and 35-4-140 are created to

- 14 (a) Any student attending the university, full or
- 15 part time, shall within thirty (30) days after the date of
- 16 enrollment provide to the appropriate university official
- 17 written documentary proof of vaccination against

1 meningococcal meningitis. For purposes of this section, 2 proof of vaccination documentary written means 3 certification by a private licensed physician or his 4 representative, or by any public health authority, that the 5 student has received a quadrivalent meningococcal conjugate vaccine. Documentation shall include month, day and year 6 of the vaccination. The president shall not permit a 7 student to attend the university for more than thirty (30) 8 9 calendar days without documentary proof of vaccination as required by this section. Waivers shall be authorized by 10 the state or county health officer upon submission of 11 written evidence of religious objection or 12 medical 13 contraindication to the administration of any vaccine. the presence of an outbreak of meningococcal meningitis, as 14 determined by the state or county health authority, 15 students for whom a waiver has been issued and who are not 16 17 immunized against meningococcal meningitis shall excluded from the university for a period of 18 time determined by the state or county health authority. 19

- 6 for the vaccination of college students against
- 7 meningococcal meningitis, as provided in W.S. 21-17-124 and
- 8 21-18-202(c)(ix). The vaccine required by this section
- 9 shall be a quadrivalent meningococcal conjugate vaccine.
