6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	
8	Section 1. W.S. 35-11-417(b) and by creating a new
9	subsection (g) is amended to read:
10	
11	35-11-417. Bonding provisions.
12	
13	(b) All bonds shall be signed by the operator as
14	principal, by a good and sufficient corporate surety
15	licensed to do business in the state, and be made payable

1	to the state of Wyoming. At the discretion of the director,
2	the record mineral owner of the land to be mined may also
3	be required to join as principal. This subsection shall not
4	apply to collateral bonds issued pursuant to subsection (g)
5	of this section.
6	
7	(g) The council may, consistent with the requirements
8	of 30 CFR 800.21(c), promulgate rules and regulations that
9	allow the administrator to accept real property posted as a
10	collateral bond without separate surety, provided that the
11	real property is located in this state, the bond provides a
12	perfected first lien security interest in the real property
13	in favor of the department and the protection provided by
14	the bond is consistent with the objectives and purposes of
15	this act.

17	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2018.
