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11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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13 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-2-913 is created to read:

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15 **35-2-913.** Exceptions.

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1 2 (a) No freestanding emergency center shall require 3 separate licensure under this act when operated by the 4 provider based emergency department of a Wyoming licensed 5 hospital. 6 7 (b) On and before June 30, 2019, freestanding 8 emergency centers operated by a hospital district or rural health care district shall not require licensure under this 9 10 act provided a hospital transfer agreement is in place. 11 12 (c) On and after July 1, 2019, freestanding emergency centers operated by a hospital district or rural health 13 care district shall comply with all licensure requirements 14 15 of this act. 16 17 **Section 2.** W.S. 35-2-901(a)(x), by creating a new paragraph (xxvi) and by amending and renumbering (xxvi) as 18 19 (xxvii) and 42-6-102(a)(ii) and (iii)(B) are amended to 20 read: 21

1 2 (a) As used in this act: 3 (ii) "Adult foster care home" means any family 4 home or facility in which residential care is provided in a 5 homelike environment for five (5) or fewer adults who are 6 not related to the provider by blood, marriage or adoption, 7 8 except in special circumstances. "Adult foster care home" 9 does not include any residential facility otherwise 10 licensed or funded by the state of Wyoming. The homes shall 11 be regulated in accordance with W.S. 35-2-901 through 12 35-2-912 35-2-913 and this act which shall govern in case of conflict; 13
