The department shall notify the obligor by certified mail, with return receipt requested, or by 6 personal service if notification by certified mail was 7 unsuccessful, that the obligor is in arrears in a child 8 9 support obligation and that the obligor's driver's license as defined in W.S. 31-7-102(a)(xxv) shall be suspended by 10 11 the department of transportation sixty (60) days after the date the obligor receives the notice unless the obligor: 12
