Driver's license suspension for child support nonpayment.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to child support enforcement; amending
2 requirements for administrative suspension of a driver's
3 license for nonpayment of child support; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 20-6-111(f) (intro) is amended to
9 read:

11 **20-6-111. Driver's license suspension; nonpayment of**
12 **child support; administrative hearings.**

14 (f) The department may determine that a driver's
15 license suspension may be better achieved through an
16 administrative suspension if the obligor owes more than
17 ~~five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)~~ two thousand five hundred

1 dollars (\$2,500.00) in unpaid child support and the obligor
2 has not made a full monthly child support payment either
3 voluntarily or through income withholding for a period of
4 at least ~~ninety (90)~~ sixty (60) consecutive days prior to
5 the determination. The department shall notify the obligor
6 by certified mail, with return receipt requested, or by
7 personal service if notification by certified mail was
8 unsuccessful, that the obligor is in arrears in a child
9 support obligation and that the obligor's driver's license
10 as defined in W.S. 31-7-102(a)(xxv) shall be suspended by
11 the department of transportation sixty (60) days after the
12 date the obligor receives the notice unless the obligor:

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
