AN ACT relating to predatory animals; prohibiting ownership 1 2 of a predator without a permit; providing a definition; providing rulemaking authority; providing a penalty; and 3 4 providing for an effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. W.S. 11-6-109 is created to read: 8 9 10 11-6-109. Predator ownership prohibited; penalty. 11 No person shall knowingly own or possess a living predator 12 13 unless the person has obtained a permit from the director of the department of agriculture giving approval to own the 14 15 predator. The director shall not issue a permit under this

1	section if the director determines that ownership of the
2	predator presents any threat to public health or safety.
3	Any person failing to comply with this section shall be
4	punished as provided in W.S. 11-1-103. The department of
5	agriculture shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to
6	implement this section. As used in this section, "predator"
7	means a predatory animal as defined in W.S.
8	23-1-101(a)(viii).
