25 **Section 2.** Six million two hundred fourteen thousand
26 three hundred ninety-three dollars (\$6,214,393.00)
27 appropriated to the board of control division within the
28 state engineer's office from water development account I

1 created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i), shall revert to water
2 development account I. Any amount of that appropriation
3 that is already expended or encumbered prior to the
4 effective date of this act shall be transferred to water
5 development account I from general funds appropriated to
6 the board of control division within the state engineer's
7 office as provided in section 1 of this act.

9 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
