**Section 2.** Six million two hundred fourteen thousand  
three hundred ninety-three dollars (\$6,214,393.00)

1 appropriated to the board of control division within the  
2 state engineer's office from water development account I  
3 created by W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i), shall revert to water  
4 development account I. Any amount of that appropriation  
5 that is already expended or encumbered prior to the  
6 effective date of this act shall be transferred to water  
7 development account I from the legislative stabilization  
8 reserve account funds appropriated to the board of control  
9 division within the state engineer's office as provided in  
10 section 1 of this act.

12       **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
15 Constitution.
