- 2 limit on state highways as specified; amending penalties
- 3 for violations of speed limits on state highways; amending
- 4 assessment of court costs for violations of speed limits as

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-301(b)(iv) and by creating a new
- 10 paragraph (vii), 31-5-302, 31-5-1201(d)(i), (ii), (v) and
- 11 (g) and 31-18-704 are amended to read:

1 31-5-301. Maximum speed limits. 2 3 (b) Except when a special hazard exists that requires 4 lower speed for compliance with subsection (a) of this section, subject to W.S. 31-5-203(b), the limits specified 5 6 in this subsection or established as otherwise authorized shall be maximum lawful speeds and no person shall drive a 7 8 vehicle on a highway at a speed in excess of maximum limits: 9 10 11 (iv) For all other locations for which a maximum 12 speed limit is not specified under this subsection, 13 sixty-five (65) miles per hour where the roadway is paved and fifty-five (55) miles per hour where the roadway is 14 15 unpaved;. However, the superintendent may designate higher 16 maximum speed limits on paved roadways pursuant to W.S. 31-5-302;

19 (vii) Seventy (70) miles per hour on state 20 highways, as defined in W.S. 31-18-101(a)(xvii), that are 21 not interstate highways, as defined in W.S. 31-18-801(a)(xvi). 22

1 31-5-302. Establishment of specific maximum speed

2 limits by superintendent.

3

4 Whenever the superintendent determines upon the basis of an 5 engineering and traffic investigation, or in the event of a vehicle or weather emergency, that a maximum speed greater 6 or less than that authorized herein is safe and reasonable 7 8 under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or 9 other place or upon any part of the state highway system, 10 the superintendent, except as provided for in 11 31-5-303(b), may determine and declare a reasonable and 12 safe maximum limit thereat, which shall be effective when 13 appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected and 14 which shall not exceed eighty (80) miles per hour on interstate highways. or seventy (70) miles per hour on 15 16 state highways, as defined in W.S. 31-18-101(a) (xvii), that are not interstate highways, as defined in W.S. 17 18 31-18-801(a)(xvi). The maximum speed limit may be declared 19 to be effective at all times or at such times as are 20 indicated upon the signs and differing limits 21 established for different times of day, different types of vehicles, varying weather conditions, and other factors 22 23 bearing on safe speeds, which shall be effective when

- 1 posted upon appropriate fixed or variable signs. This
- 2 section does not grant power to the superintendent to
- 3 declare statewide or countywide maximum speed limits but
- 4 grants power to declare maximum speed limits for the public
- 5 safety in localized geographic areas.
