## A BILL

## for

ACT relating to 1 AN instream flows; providing for 2 acquisition of temporary instream flows; and providing for an effective date. 3 4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 5 6 7 Section 1. W.S. 41-3-110 by creating a new subsection (b), by amending and renumbering (b) as (c) and by 8 renumbering (c) and (d) as (d) and (e), 41-3-1002(c) and 9 41-3-1007 are amended to read: 10 11 41-3-110. Right to acquire temporary water rights for 12 highway or railroad roadbed construction or repair; right 13

14 to acquire temporary water rights for instream flows; 15 application; restrictions; fee.

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1	(b) The state shall have the right to acquire by							
2	purchase, gift or lease the right to the use of water which							
3	may be embraced in any adjudicated or valid unadjudicated							
4	water right, or any portion thereof, for a period of not to							
5	exceed two (2) years, for instream flow purposes, on its							
6	own behalf, provided:							
7								
8	(i) Only the state shall have the authority to							
9	acquire the water pursuant to W.S. 41-3-1007(a)(ii); and							
10								
11	(ii) Any temporary transfer shall be allowed							
12	<u>only:</u>							
13								
14	(A) Downstream to the next nonparticipating							
15	landowner's headgate;							
16								
17	(B) If no other appropriator is injured							
18	thereby; and							
19								
20	(C) The water to be transferred has been							
21	used within the past five (5) years according to the terms							
22	of the current permit.							
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1 (b) (c) Before any right to such use pursuant to subsection (a) or (b) of this section 2 shall become 3 operative, an application must be made in writing on a form provided or designated by the state engineer, with a copy 4 5 of any conveyance or agreement provided, and it shall be filed in the office of the state engineer for his 6 ratification and approval. Upon approval by the state 7 engineer, an order authorizing such use and designating the 8 9 method, place, and period of use may be entered. No loss, 10 abandonment or impairment of such water rights shall occur 11 or attach as a result of such change or use, except as provided by said conveyance or agreement and order of the 12 13 state engineer, and upon termination of the temporary 14 diversion and use, as stated in the order, any affected right to the use of water shall automatically be reinvested 15 with all the rights, privileges and uses, and purposes 16 17 theretofore held and enjoyed.

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19 (c)(d) Only that portion of a water right so acquired 20 which has been consumptively used under the historical use 21 made of the water right, may be diverted by a temporary 22 user. In determining the consumptive use of water rights 23 for the direct use of the natural unstored flow of any 24 stream for irrigation purposes, the return flow from those

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1 rights shall be presumed to be fifty percent (50%). In 2 those situations where an assumption of fifty percent (50%) 3 return flow would be significantly in error, the state 4 engineer shall have the prerogative of making а 5 determination of the actual amount of return flow, and the amount of water which can be diverted for the temporary use 6 provided herein shall be adjusted accordingly. The actual 7 historic return flow, or the assumed return flow of fifty 8 9 percent (50%) will be left in the stream for the use of 10 downstream appropriators. The foregoing formula and procedure for the determination of consumptive use and 11 return flow shall be limited to this section and shall have 12 no application to any other statute of the state of 13 14 Wyoming. Nothing herein contained shall be treated or construed as changing the prior use of water held by said 15 owner or owners and as provided by the laws of the state of 16 17 Wyoming.

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19 (d) (e) The state engineer shall assess a fee not to 20 exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for his review and 21 approval of temporary water agreements. This fee shall 22 accompany the agreement application and shall be retained 23 and credited to the general fund whether the agreement or 24 request is approved or denied.

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2 41-3-1002. Instream flows to be by stream segment; 3 waters for permanent instream flows may be sold, 4 transferred or otherwise conveyed under certain 5 restrictions; ownership restricted. 6 (c) Storage water appropriated for the purpose of 7 providing instream flows in specified stream segments or 8 9 existing water rights which are permanently converted to 10 instream flow under provisions of W.S. 41 3 1007 11 41-3-1007(a)(i) of this act may later be sold, transferred or otherwise conveyed to any other purpose pursuant to the 12 requirements of W.S. 41-3-104, except that the board of 13 control shall require that an advertised public hearing be 14 held. 15 16 17 41-3-1007. Acquisition of existing rights for instream flow purposes. 18 19 The state of Wyoming may: 20 (a) 21 22 (i) Permanently acquire any existing water rights in streams of Wyoming by transfer or gift for the 23 purpose of providing instream flows, provided that a change 24

1 in use of the right acquired shall be in accordance with 2 W.S. 41-3-104 $\underline{\cdot}$ 

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4 <u>(ii) Temporarily acquire any existing water</u> 5 <u>rights in streams of Wyoming by purchase, gift or lease for</u> 6 <u>the purpose of providing instream flows, provided that a</u> 7 <u>change in use of the right acquired shall be in accordance</u> 8 with W.S. 41-3-110.

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10 (b) Any right acquired and changed shall be in the name of the state of Wyoming and shall be administered by 11 the state engineer and the board of control, who shall 12 insure that the use of water for instream flows shall not 13 interfere with existing water rights or impair the value of 14 such rights or related property. The game and fish 15 commission shall act as a petitioner in a petition for 16 change in use under this section. 17

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19 (b) (c) Any such water rights acquired and changed 20 shall be limited to a specified stream segment by the board 21 of control with priority date intact.
