A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to wildlife; extending the wildlife trust  
2 challenge account; and providing for an effective date.

4 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6 **Section 1.** 2008 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 48,  
7 Section 326(a) and (b), as amended by 2010 Wyoming Session  
8 Laws, Chapter 39, Section 337, is amended to read:

10 **Section 326.**

12 (a) The Wyoming wildlife trust challenge  
13 account created by 2006 Wyoming Session Laws,  
14 Chapter 35, Section 320 is continued. Any  
15 unexpended, unobligated monies appropriated from  
16 the general fund to the account by 2006 Wyoming

1 Session Laws, Chapter 35, Section 320 shall not  
2 revert on June 30, 2010 and shall remain in the  
3 account for the purpose of providing a state  
4 match pursuant to subsections (c) through (e) of  
5 this section. Unexpended, unobligated monies in  
6 the account on June 30, ~~2012~~2015 shall revert as  
7 provided by law. The state treasurer shall  
8 invest monies within the account and shall  
9 deposit the earnings from investments to the  
10 general fund.

11

12 (b) To the extent funds are available in  
13 the wildlife trust challenge account, the state  
14 treasurer shall match gifts actually received  
15 during the donation period provided in this  
16 subsection by the Wyoming wildlife and natural  
17 resource trust account board. A match shall be  
18 paid under this section by the state treasurer  
19 following any accumulated gift amounts actually  
20 received by the Wyoming wildlife and natural  
21 resource trust account board in a total of five  
22 thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or more. The match  
23 shall be made by transferring from the wildlife  
24 trust challenge account to the Wyoming wildlife

1           and natural resource trust account created by  
2           W.S. 9-15-103(a) an amount equal to the  
3           accumulated amount of the gift. The match  
4           applies to gifts received during the donation  
5           period commencing July 1, 2006 and ending June  
6           30, ~~2012~~2015.

8           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
9   completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
11 Constitution.
