AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Wildlife and Natural 1 2 Resource Funding Act; providing for funding of projects under that act; specifying large projects approved 3 for funding in 2014; amending funding and timing for 4 specified previously approved large projects; requiring 5 specified conservation easements to include the state of 6 Wyoming as a third party beneficiary as specified; 7 requiring certifications regarding kickbacks and gifts; 8 providing appropriations; providing for reversion of funds; 9 and providing for an effective date. 10

Section 4. Before any distribution of funds is made 11 pursuant to the appropriations authorized by Sections 1 and 12 13 2 of this act, the person receiving the funds shall certify 14 gratuities, kickbacks, gifts, commissions, no contingency fees or other considerations have been or will 15 be made in connection with the appropriation or the 16 17 associated grant made by the Wyoming wildlife and natural resource trust account board. 18
