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- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 20-2-305(a), 20-6-111(f)(intro) and
- 10 20-6-210(a)(intro) are amended to read:

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12 **20-2-305.** Abatements.

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- 14 (a) Unless otherwise ordered by the court, child
- 15 support shall abate by one-half (1/2) of the daily support
- 16 obligation for each day the noncustodial parent has
- 17 physical custody of the child for whom support is due,

2 child for fifteen (15) or more consecutive days. The daily

3 support obligation shall be computed by multiplying the

4 monthly child support obligation by twelve (12) and

5 dividing the product by three hundred and sixty-five (365).

7 whether the noncustodial parent has met the consecutive day

8 requirement of this subsection, overnight and weekend

9 visits with the custodial parent during the period for

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(f) The department may determine that a driver's 15 license suspension may be better achieved through an 16 17 administrative suspension if the obligor owes more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in unpaid child support 18 and the obligor has not made a full monthly child support 19 20 payment either voluntarily or through income withholding 21 for a period of at least ninety (90) consecutive days prior 22 to the determination.
