A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state employees; providing for a
2 representative of the judicial branch on the state employee
3 compensation commission; and providing for an effective
4 date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1019(e) is amended to read:

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10 **9-2-1019. Personnel hearings; state employee**
11 **compensation commission created; duties.**

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13 (e) The state employee compensation commission is
14 created to review issues related to employee compensation.
15 The commission shall consist of not more than ~~five (5)~~ six
16 (6) members to serve two (2) year terms. Three (3) members

1 shall be appointed by the management council of the
2 legislature of whom one (1) shall be from the private
3 sector, and one (1) each from the senate and house of
4 representatives. ~~and~~ Two (2) members shall be appointed by
5 the governor, of whom one (1) shall be from the private
6 sector. One (1) member shall be appointed by the chief
7 justice of the Wyoming supreme court. The commission shall
8 elect a chairman from among its two (2) legislative
9 members.

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11 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14 Constitution.
