	VETERINARY TECHNICIANS 33-30-301. Certification required.

Any veterinarian licensed to practice veterinary medicine 1 2 in the state of Wyoming may use the services of one (1) or 3 more registered veterinary technicians. No person shall practice as a veterinary technician unless the person is 4 5 registered by the board under this article. A registered veterinary technician who is employed by a licensed 6 veterinarian is not considered to be 7 enqaqed in the practice of veterinary medicine. 8

10 **33-30-302.** Requirement for a certificate.

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(a) The board may issue a certificate as a veterinary
technician to any applicant who files an application upon a
form and in the manner prescribed by the board, accompanied
by the appropriate fee and who furnishes satisfactory
evidence to the board of the following:

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18 (i) The applicant has reached the age of19 majority;

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(ii) The applicant has no felony or misdemeanor convictions involving moral turpitude, although exceptions to this requirement may be granted by the board if consistent with the public interest;

1 2 The applicant has successfully completed (iii) 3 an accredited program in veterinary technology as approved 4 by the board or has other training and experience which the 5 board determines is adequate. 6 The board may, in its sole discretion, require 7 (b) the applicant to appear before the board. 8 9 (c) Upon examination of all credentials, the board 10 credentials adequate evidence 11 may consider the of professional competence and issue a certificate. 12 13 33-30-303. Supervision. 14 15 (a) A veterinary technician shall only work as a 16 17 veterinary technician under the direction or supervision of a licensed veterinarian who employs the technician. 18 19 20 (b) The licensed veterinarian who employs а 21 registered veterinary technician is responsible for the acts of the technician, and nothing in this article 22 employer of the ordinary duties and 23 relieves the responsibilities for the acts or conduct of the employee. 24

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2 (c) A veterinary technician shall not maintain or operate any office separate from the office of the licensed 3 4 veterinarian who employs the technician. 5 33-30-304. Reciprocity. 6 7 A person who has been issued a certificate to practice as a 8 9 veterinary technician under the laws of any other state having requirements substantially equal to those provided 10 for in this article may, after consideration by the board, 11 be issued a certificate to practice in this state. 12 13 33-30-305. Rulemaking authority. 14 15 16 The board shall adopt rules necessary for the 17 implementation of this article. 18 19 Section 2. (a) When used in this act, these words and phrases, 1 2 unless the context otherwise indicates, shall be defined as follows: 3 4 5 (x) "Veterinary technician" means a person who is registered as a veterinary technician by the board; 6 7 (xi) "This act" means W.S. 33-30-201 through 8 9 33-30-215 and 33-30-301 through 33-30-305. 10 33-30-214. Penalty for violation; injunction. 11 12 Any person who violates W.S. 33-30-101 through 13 (a) 33-30-215 or 33-30-301 through 33-30-305 is guilty of a 14 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than seven 15 hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), by imprisonment for not 16 more than six (6) months, or both. Each act of such 17 unlawful practice shall constitute a distinct and separate 18 19 offense. 20
