1	(b) An individual who performs service for wages is
2	an employee for purposes of this act unless it is shown
3	that the individual:

5	(i) Is Has been and will continue to be free
6	from control or and direction over the details of in
7	<pre>connection with the performance of the services, by both</pre>
8	under the contract for the performance of service and by in
9	fact;

11	(vii) Performs service either outside the usual
12	course of the business for which the service is performed
13	or is performed outside of all the places of business of
14	the enterprise for which the service is performed; and

16	(viii) Is customarily engaged in an
17	independently established trade, occupation, profession or
18	business of the same nature as that involved in the service
19	performed.

1	(xxiii) "Independent contractor" means an
