- 10 (a) There is appropriated twenty-four million four
- 11 hundred thousand dollars (\$24,400,000.00) from the general
- 12 fund to the business ready community account. This
- 13 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the
- 14 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2018. This
- 15 appropriation shall only be expended as specified in

1 subsection (b) of this section. Notwithstanding any other

2 provision of law, this appropriation shall not be

3 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any

4 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

5 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

6 2018.

The Wyoming business council shall only expend 8 (b) 9 the funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this section loan not to exceed the amount 10 by providing one (1) 11 appropriated in subsection (a) of this section to the first city that files a complete application as specified under 12 13 this section and in accordance with W.S. 9-12-601 for the 14 development or expansion of an economic development project. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the 15 applicable provisions of W.S. 9-12-601 shall apply to the 16 17 loan. The loan made under this section shall be a loan and not a grant. The Wyoming business council shall not provide 18 a loan under this section unless the city certifies to the 19 20 council in an application made pursuant to W.S. 9-12-601(b) 21 that it has received a commitment of at least seventy-one 22 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$71,500,000.00) in matching funds as a private investment for the project. The 23 24 loan made under this section is not subject to

1 limitations specified in W.S. 9-12-601(d). The repayment of

2 the loan is not subject to the provisions of W.S.

3 9-12-601(g), repayment of the loan shall be credited to the

4 general fund.

6 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

9 Constitution.
