for

1 AN ACT relating to the business ready community program; 2 amending requirements for grants and loans under the 3 program; providing for the recapture of funds associated 4 with grants and loans under the program; removing a 5 restriction on interest rates for loans; making conforming 6 amendments; requiring rulemaking; specifying applicability; 7 and providing for effective dates.

11 Section 1. W.S. 9-12-601(c) and (g) is amended to

1	(c) Grants shall be matching grants as determined by
2	the council. Loans shall be made at no or low interest
3	rates. Grants and loans made under this section shall be
4	subject to the following conditions:
5	
6	(i) The minimum interest rate for loans shall be
7	set at the prevailing United States department of treasury
8	rate for bonds of comparable maturity to the loan term;
9	
10	(ii) Grants for revenue generating projects
11	shall provide for repayment of the grant funds in
12	accordance with the following:
13	
14	(A) The minimum revenue recapture
15	percentage shall be not less than the percentage of the
16	project cost covered by the grant, provided that the
17	revenue recapture percentage for a project covered by a
18	grant shall not exceed fifty percent (50%);
19	
20	(B) The amount of revenue recaptured may
20 21	exceed the amount of the original grant;

1	(C) Revenue generated by the project may be
2	recaptured for the full expected life of the revenue
3	generating asset.

5	(iii) If a project that is covered in whole or
б	in part by a grant or a loan under this section is sold,
7	assigned or transferred:
8	
9	(A) The revenues generated by the sale,
10	assignment or transfer shall be utilized to retire the
11	project loan, if a loan was issued to cover part or all of
12	the project costs;
13	
14	(B) After the loan is paid in full or if a
15	grant was used to cover part or all of the project costs, a
16	percentage of revenues not less than the percentage of the
17	project cost covered by the grant or loan that are
18	generated by the sale, assignment or transfer shall be
19	remitted to the council and deposited in the business ready
20	community account under W.S. 9-12-602.
21	

(g) Repayments of loans under this section shall becredited to the business ready community account. The

1	council shall promulgate rules and regulations to identify
2	the type and maximum amount, as a percentage of the total
3	grant, of the revenue that may be recaptured and credited
4	to the account as a result of grants under this section,
5	subject to subparagraph (c)(ii)(A) of this section.

8	apply to grants and loans issued on or after the effective
9	date of this section.
