- 14 (b) Scholarships under this section shall be for a
- 15 maximum of the equivalent of eight (8) full-time semesters.
- 16 Except as specified under subsection (g) of this section, a

1 scholarship under this section shall be available for

2 attendance at a Wyoming community college for not more than

3 a maximum of the equivalent of four (4) full-time

4 semesters.

(g) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, a 6 scholarship received under this section for attendance at a 7 Wyoming community college for four (4) full-time semesters 8 9 may be extended for continued attendance at a community college by a student who otherwise remains eligible for 10 11 that scholarship under this article, and that student has earned a certificate or degree from a community college or 12 13 has otherwise successfully completed sufficient courses for 14 eligibility to enroll in courses within a program offered by a community college which leads to a baccalaureate or 15 other professional degree. A scholarship extended under 16 17 this subsection shall not exceed the maximum equivalent of eight (8) full-time semesters when combined with the four 18 19 (4) full-time semesters of initial community college attendance under the scholarship. 20
