1	history, the federal government's implementation of the
2	National Historic Preservation Act can undermine the rights
3	of private property owners, inhibit economic activity
4	critical to the state of Wyoming and suppress revenue to
5	the state, local and federal governments. The legislature
6	further finds that these negative effects can be limited if
7	a federal agency refrains from imposing any delay or
8	restriction on a permit based on any viewshed or similar
9	requirement on private property.

11	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
12	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14	Constitution.
