A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; amending specifications
2 for license plates and special license plates; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-204(b) and 31-2-213(d)(iii)(B)

8 are amended to read:

10 **31-2-204. Issuance of certificates of registration**
11 **and license plates by county; form.**

13 (b) Except as otherwise provided, license plates
14 shall be of metal not less than twelve (12) inches long in
15 the left-hand end of which shall be arabic numerals for the
16 county in which issued, followed by the bucking horse and

1 rider emblem and a distinctive number assigned to the
2 vehicle, set forth in numerals and letters as determined by
3 the department and above or underneath such numerals shall
4 be the word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the year of
5 issue or validation. License plates issued to dealers and
6 for state or federal official forestry vehicles,
7 motorcycles, multipurpose vehicles and trailers shall
8 contain appropriate identification which may be in lieu of
9 the bucking horse and rider emblem. After the county number
10 on the left-hand end, the license plate may also contain a
11 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the
12 department, indicating vehicle type. License plates shall
13 be changed or validated annually. There shall be a marked
14 contrast between the color of the plate and that of the
15 numerals and letters and the background of all plates shall
16 be fully reflectorized. Plates for light utility trailers
17 under one thousand (1,000) pounds, motorcycles and
18 multipurpose vehicles shall not be less than three (3)
19 inches wide and six (6) inches long. Antique license plates
20 shall bear no date and shall bear the inscription "Pioneer
21 Wyo". License stickers for trucks and trailers used by any
22 farmer or rancher for the transportation of livestock, feed
23 or unprocessed agricultural products owned and produced by
24 the farmer or rancher from the place of production to

1 market and of ranch supplies intended solely for the use of
2 the farmer or rancher, and not for sale, on the return
3 trip, and not for the transportation of goods and persons
4 for hire shall bear the inscription "Farm". Upon
5 application to the department and payment of a fee as
6 provided by W.S. 31-3-102(a)(xix), veteran license stickers
7 bearing the inscription "Veteran" and designating the
8 conflict service of the veteran may be issued to the
9 veterans' commission in a format approved by the
10 department. The veterans' commission may sell the veteran
11 license sticker to qualified veterans at a fee not to
12 exceed cost, plus ten dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle. Any
13 fees collected by the veterans' commission under this
14 subsection shall be deposited in the veterans' commission
15 expendable trust fund. The veterans' commission shall
16 establish eligibility criteria for veterans applying for a
17 veteran license sticker. A qualified veteran purchasing a
18 veteran license sticker manufactured by the department and
19 sold by the veterans' commission may display the sticker on
20 the license plate issued by the county treasurer. The
21 provisions of W.S. 31-2-205(a)(iv) shall not apply to any
22 veteran license sticker manufactured by the department and
23 displayed as provided in this section.

2 certificates, plates and stickers; removable windshield

5 (d) As used in this section:

7 (iii) "Special license plate" means a license
8 plate that displays the international symbol of access:

9

10 (B) The plate shall consist of the arabic
11 numerals designating the county in which issued at the
12 left, followed by the bucking horse and rider emblem and a
13 distinctive combination of up to three (3) numbers and
14 letters as determined by the department, followed by the
15 international symbol of access. After the county number on
16 the left-hand end, the license plate may also contain a
17 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the
18 department, indicating the vehicle type. A special license
19 plate issued for a motorcycle shall not be less than three
20 (3) inches wide and six (6) inches long and shall contain
21 the international symbol of access and appropriate
22 identification which may be in lieu of the bucking horse
23 and rider emblem.
