A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;

2 requiring studies and reports for the operations of

3 government; and providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** [Governor's Office-Infrastructure Grants]
- 8 During the 2023-2024 fiscal biennium, the governor's office
- 9 shall report quarterly to the legislature through the joint
- 10 appropriations committee on the use of any funds
- 11 appropriated for purposes of securing infrastructure
- 12 grants, including the result of expenditures and grants
- 13 secured.

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- 15 **Section 2.** [Governor's Office-Wyoming Innovation
- 16 Partnership] The governor's office shall establish

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- 1 appropriate metrics to measure the intended outputs and
- 2 outcomes of the Wyoming innovation partnership. The
- 3 governor's office shall include a report of the established
- 4 metrics and results within any biennial budget request
- 5 submitted under W.S. 9-2-1013 during the 2023-2024 fiscal
- 6 biennium in which the governor's office requests funding
- 7 for the Wyoming innovation partnership.

- 9 **Section 3.** [State Treasurer's Office-Transactions]
- 10 Effective beginning September 30, 2022 and ending July 1,
- 11 2024, not later than ninety (90) days after the end of each
- 12 calendar quarter, the state treasurer's office shall
- 13 provide a reconciliation of cash and investment earnings
- 14 for all transactions conducted in the prior quarter to the
- 15 joint appropriations committee and select committee on
- 16 capital financing and investments.

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- 18 **Section 4.** [State Treasurer's Office-Operational
- 19 Audit Recommendations]

- 21 (a) Not later than October 1, 2022 and October 1,
- 22 2023, the state treasurer's office shall report to the
- 23 joint appropriations committee and select committee on

- 1 capital financing and investments on the advice of the
- 2 investment funds committee on the following:

- 4 (i) The steps taken to respond to the
- 5 recommendations in the operational audit of the investments
- 6 and financial accounting within the state treasurer's
- 7 office funded in 2020 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 80,
- 8 Section 2, Section 060, footnote 2;

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- 10 (ii) Each operational audit's recommendation and
- 11 the implementation status of each recommendation.

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- 13 **Section** 5. [State Treasurer's Office-Monthly
- 14 Information Reports]

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- 16 (a) During the period beginning July 1, 2022 and
- 17 ending June 30, 2024, the state treasurer's office shall
- 18 provide monthly information reports to the state loan and
- 19 investment board and the legislature through the joint
- 20 appropriations committee concerning the following:

- 22 (i) The monthly and fiscal year status of all
- 23 distributions and transfers of state funds required by law

- 1 to occur during the relevant period and the expected date
- 2 for the completion of the distributions and transfers;

- 4 (ii) The monthly and fiscal year status of
- 5 investment earnings, interest, dividends and realized and
- 6 unrealized gains and losses for each of the investment
- 7 pools under the control of the state treasurer's office and
- 8 separately for each investment manager under contract with
- 9 the state treasurer's office;

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- 11 (iii) Any issues, including delays, identified
- 12 by the state treasurer's office related to investment and
- 13 accounting of funds under the control of the state
- 14 treasurer's office and any actions planned or taken to
- 15 address the identified issues.

- 17 Section 6. [Wyoming Tourism Board-Quebec 01] Not
- 18 later than June 30, 2024, the Wyoming tourism board shall
- 19 report to the joint appropriations committee and joint
- 20 travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources interim
- 21 committee on the design, cost, location and improvements to
- 22 interpretive updates and signage at the northeast and

- 1 southeast Wyoming welcome centers and Quebec 01 state
- 2 historic site.

- 4 Section 7. [Department of Corrections-Mental Health
- 5 and Substance Use Disorder Programming] Not later than
- 6 October 1, 2022 and October 1, 2023, the department of
- 7 corrections shall report to the joint judiciary interim
- 8 committee and joint appropriations committee on the use and
- 9 results of any funds appropriated for purposes of mental
- 10 health and substance use disorder programming in accordance
- 11 with 2020 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 152.

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- 13 **Section 8.** [Department of Corrections-Incentives and
- 14 Alternative Sanctions] Not later than October 1, 2022 and
- 15 October 1, 2023, the department of corrections shall report
- 16 to the joint judiciary interim committee and joint
- 17 appropriations committee on the use of any funds
- 18 appropriated for purposes of incentives and alternative
- 19 sanctions for probation and parole supervision in

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20 accordance with 2019 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 116.

1 Section 9. This act is effective July 1, 2022.
