DUI-child endangerment fines.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the operation of motor vehicles;  
2 providing a fine for child endangerment while driving under  
3 the influence; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-233(m) (i) is amended to read:

8

9 **31-5-233. Driving or having control of vehicle while**  
10 **under influence of intoxicating liquor or controlled**  
11 **substances; penalties.**

13 (m) Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older  
14 who has a child passenger in the vehicle during a violation  
15 of this section shall be punished upon conviction as  
16 follows:

1           (i) For a first conviction under this  
2 subsection, by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year,  
3 a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars  
4 (\$750.00), or both;

6           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
