A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; creating a
2 select legislative committee to review state revenues;
3 specifying study criteria; providing for a report;
4 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

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11 (a) There is created a select committee on state
12 revenues. The committee shall be comprised of the
13 president of the senate, the speaker of the house, the
14 chairmen of the senate and house revenue and appropriations
15 committees, the majority and minority floor leaders of the

1 senate and house and a member of the house selected jointly
2 by the senate president and house speaker not later than
3 March 15, 2017. The speaker of the house and the president
4 of the senate shall be co-chairmen of the select committee.
5 The select committee shall continue in existence until
6 March 31, 2018.

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8 (b) The select committee shall conduct a review of
9 projected state revenues and potential modifications of
10 revenue streams and potential additional revenue options.

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12 (c) All state agencies, commissions, departments and
13 other state entities shall cooperate with and provide all
14 requested information to the select committee. The
15 committee may conduct public hearings and create
16 subcommittees as it determines advisable.

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18 (d) The select committee shall sponsor legislation
19 for introduction in the 2018 budget session as it
20 determines appropriate for modification to revenue streams
21 and potential additional revenue options which would
22 provide sufficient revenue to fund ongoing state
23 operations, including state funding of K-12 education

1 operations and capital construction funding in light of
2 current revenue projections, provided that no legislation
3 shall be introduced unless a majority of the members of the
4 select committee from each house approve the proposed
5 legislation.

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7 **Section 2.** There is appropriated fifty thousand
8 dollars (\$50,000.00) from the general fund to the
9 legislative service office for purposes of this act. This
10 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the
11 effective date of this act and ending July 1, 2018.

12
13 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
16 Constitution.
