- 13 (a) A person is guilty of strangulation if he
- 14 intentionally and knowingly impedes or attempts to impede
- 15 the normal breathing or circulation of the blood of a
- 16 household member, as defined by W.S. 35-21-102, by:

2 (i) Applying pressure on the throat or neck of 3 the household member; or

5 (ii) Blocking the nose or mouth of the household 6 member.

8 (b) A person who commits the acts described in 9 subsection (a) of this section is guilty of strangulation

whether or not the household member suffers injury.

(c) No person shall be guilty of strangulation when performing the acts described in subsection (a) of this section as part of a legitimate medical or dental procedure, as part of the practices of a religious belief or as part of the duties of a peace officer as defined by W.S. 6-1-104(a)(vi).

19 (d) Strangulation of a household member is a felony 20 punishable by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) 21 years.
