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10 29-1-201. Definitions; agency relationships presumed.

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- 12 (a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this

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- 15 (xii) "Send" or "sent" means, in connection with
- 16 any writing or written notice, to deposit in the mail or

deliver for transmission by any other usual means of 1 communication with postage or cost of transmission provided 2 3 for and properly addressed and, in the case of 4 instrument to an address specified thereon or otherwise 5 agreed, or if no address is specified, to any address reasonable under the circumstances. The foregoing method 6 of delivery includes delivery by any commercial carrier 7 that requests and maintains a receipt for delivery of 8 9 written documents and also includes an electronic record as set forth in the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act if the 10 sender and recipient have previously communicated by 11 electronic means. In the event any writing is transmitted 12 13 by mail with the United States postal service, such writing shall be mailed by first class, postage prepaid certified 14 mail, return receipt requested, or by mail delivery 15 requiring a receipt for delivery. The time a writing is 16 17 deemed to have been sent is the time at which the writing is deposited in the mail or delivered for transmission by 18 any other means and, in the case of an electronic record, 19 the time of sending is as specified in W.S. 40-21-115; 20

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29-2-101. Persons entitled to liens; extent of lien

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1 (a) Except as provided in W.S. 29-2-113, every 2 contractor, subcontractor or materialman performing any 3 work on or furnishing any materials for any building or any 4 improvement upon real property shall have for his work done 5 or plans or materials furnished a lien upon the building or improvements, and upon the real property of the owner on 6 which they are situated to the extent of one (1) acre. If 7 the improvements cover more than one (1) acre the lien 8 9 shall extend to all the additional real property covered 10 thereby.

The contractor shall provide to subcontractors 15 materialmen at the time of contracting with them the name 16 17 and address of the record owner and his agent, applicable, and legal description of the site of the 18 project on which work will be performed or materials 19 20 furnished. Failure of a contractor to provide information 21 to subcontractors or materialmen as required by this 22 section shall cause the contractor to lose the right to 23 file a lien under this chapter for the work performed by
