Capitol building oversight group.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;  
2 providing for membership on the state capitol building  
3 rehabilitation and oversight group; providing for hiring of  
4 an oversight group manager; providing for security for  
5 certain statewide elected officials during the capitol  
6 renovation and restoration project; providing  
7 applicability; providing appropriations; and providing for  
8 an effective date.

10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-5-111(a) by creating a new  
13 paragraph (v) and by creating new subsections (f) and (g)  
14 is amended to read:

15

1           **9-5-111. State capitol building rehabilitation and**  
2 **restoration project oversight group; creation; duties.**

3  
4           (a) There is created a state capitol building  
5 rehabilitation and restoration oversight group comprised  
6 of:

7  
8           (v) A former legislative member of the oversight  
9 group selected by the president of the senate not later  
10 than January 7, 2017 and by January 7 of each odd numbered  
11 year thereafter.

12  
13           (f) Members of the oversight group who are not the  
14 governor or members of the legislature shall receive the  
15 same salary, per diem and mileage as members of the  
16 legislature traveling to and from meetings or while in  
17 actual attendance at meetings of the oversight group and  
18 during the performance of their duties relative thereto.

19  
20           (g) The oversight group may employ and retain an  
21 oversight group project manager and other individuals with  
22 technical, architectural or construction management  
23 expertise as deemed necessary by the oversight group.

1 Individuals retained or employed under this section shall  
2 have duties as assigned by the oversight group and shall  
3 report directly to the oversight group.

5 **Section 2.**

6  
7 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to  
8 the Wyoming department of transportation two hundred  
9 thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) to provide, from the  
10 effective date of this act through June 30, 2016, contract  
11 security services for statewide elected officials as  
12 provided in this act. The Wyoming highway patrol shall  
13 include a request for funds to provide contract security  
14 services pursuant to this act in its 2017-2018 standard  
15 budget request.

16  
17 (b) There is appropriated from the general fund to  
18 the legislative service office two hundred thousand dollars  
19 (\$200,000.00) to provide for the retention of an oversight  
20 group project manager as provided in section 1 of this act,  
21 from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2016.

1           **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon the  
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
4 Constitution.
