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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-2-1101 through 35-2-1104 is

- 12 UNCOMPENSATED HOSPITAL CARE

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14 **35-2-1101**. **Definitions**.

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1	(a) As used in this article:
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3	(i) "Acute care hospital" means a hospital
4	licensed in Wyoming pursuant to W.S. 35-2-901 through
5	35-2-911 and which provides acute patient care;
6	
7	(ii) "Department" means the Wyoming department
8	of health.
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10	35-2-1102. Uncompensated care fund established.
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12	(a) The uncompensated hospital care account is
13	established. The following shall apply to the account:
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15	(i) Funds in the account are continuously
16	appropriated to the department and shall be distributed on
17	a quarterly basis to all hospitals in the state to reduce
18	hospitals' costs for uncompensated care;
19	
20	(ii) Funds in the account shall not be
21	distributed for costs incurred before July 1 2015

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1 (b) The department shall promulgate rules and 2 regulations to administer the fund. The rules and 3 regulations shall include provisions for: 4 5 (i) Ensuring that reimbursements do not exceed 6 available funds; 7 8 (ii) Limiting reimbursement to the necessary 9 support of the poor; 10 11 (iii) Preventing duplication between 12 distributions from the account and proceeds from Medicaid 13 or other third party payors; 14 15 (iv) Providing for hospital reports 16 distributions commencing with the calendar quarter beginning July 1, 2015. 17 18 19 (c) The department may contract with a fiscal agent 20 to make the actual payments and conduct any necessary 21 audits or distribution requests. Distribution requests shall be made in a form and manner prescribed by the 22

department. The department or its agent on its behalf may

1	request any documentation it deems necessary to support any
2	request for reimbursement.

4	35-2-1103. Uncompensated care; hospital reports.
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6	(a) Each acute care hospital shall report to the
7	department for each calendar quarter:
8	
9	(i) The total number of hospital inpatient days
10	for all patients admitted to the hospital who were
11	qualified Medicaid recipients at the time of admission; and
12	
13	(ii) The total number of patients treated in the
14	hospital's emergency room, but who were not admitted for an
15	overnight hospital stay, and who were qualified Medicaid
16	recipients at the time of treatment.
17	
18	35-2-1104. Uncompensated hospital care account;
19	distributions.
20	
21	(a) The department shall distribute available funds
22	in the uncompensated hospital care account to hospitals on
23	a pro rata basis reflecting the relative proportion of each

- 1 hospital's quarterly total of inpatient days and emergency
- 2 room patients reported pursuant to W.S. 35-2-1103 to the
- 3 statewide cumulative quarterly total of inpatient days and
- 4 emergency room patients for all hospitals.

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- 6 (b) For purposes of distributions pursuant to
- 7 subsection (a) of this section, available funds shall be
- 8 the total of all funds appropriated for this purpose,
- 9 divided by the number of calendar quarters remaining in the
- 10 period for which the appropriation was made.

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- 12 **Section 2.** There is appropriated ten million dollars
- 13 (\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund to the uncompensated
- 14 hospital care account created by W.S. 35-2-1102.
- 15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
- 16 appropriation shall not be included in the 2017-2018
- 17 standard biennial budget. This appropriation shall be
- 18 expended quarterly only as provided by W.S. 35-2-1104(b).

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20 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2015.
