1 AN ACT relating to the University of Wyoming and community

2 college boards of trustees; modifying the board president's

3 title; allowing an increase in University of Wyoming board

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-6-101(a)(i)(D)(II), 21-17-203,

10 21-17-205, 21-17-404(a)(xv), 21-17-418(a), 21-18-302(a),

11 21-18-303(a)(xii) and 21-18-314(e) are amended to read:

13 16-6-1001. Capital construction projects

(a) Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, any 1 2 funds appropriated or authorized for expenditure for 3 capital construction projects shall be subject to the 4 restrictions of this section which shall be construed where possible as complimentary and consistent with other 5 statutory requirements relating to competitive bidding and 6 contractor preferences. To the extent the restrictions in 7 8 this section are inconsistent with other state statutes, this section shall supersede all such inconsistent 9 10 provisions and shall govern. This section shall be applied 11 as follows: 12 13 (i) This paragraph shall apply to any alternate design and construction delivery method as defined in W.S. 14 15 16-6-701(a)(v): 16 17 (D) Any waiver shall be approved in writing by the following persons: 18 19 20 (II) For projects to be completed by 21 the University of Wyoming, by the president of the university and the president chairman of the board of 22

2 21-17-203. To be body corporate; powers, duties and 3 functions generally.

4

The board of trustees and their successors in office 5 constitute a body corporate by the name of "the trustees of 6 the University of Wyoming". They possess all the powers 7 8 necessary or convenient to accomplish the objects and perform the duties prescribed by law, and shall have 9 10 custody of the books, records, buildings and all other property of the university. The board shall elect a 11 12 president chairman, secretary and treasurer, who shall 13 perform the duties prescribed in the bylaws of the board. 14 The treasurer shall execute a bond, with approved sureties 15 in double the sum likely to come into his hands, for the 16 faithful discharge of his duties. The term of office of board officers, their duties severally and the times for 17 18 holding meetings shall be fixed in the bylaws of the board. 19 A majority of the board constitutes a quorum for the 20 transaction of business but a less number may adjourn from 21 time to time, and all routine business may be entrusted to an executive committee of at least three (3) members 22 23 subject to such conditions as the bylaws of the board

prescribe. The board may from time to time appoint and 1 2 authorize a person to examine and approve for payment all 3 legal claims against the corporation. The person shall give bond with surety approved by the board, payable to the 4 5 state of Wyoming in such sum as the board may fix, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties. A 6 certificate of appointment signed by the president chairman 7 8 and secretary of the board and the bond shall be filed with the state auditor. At each meeting of the board all action 9 10 taken by the person so appointed subsequent to the 11 immediately preceding board meeting shall be submitted to 12 the board for its approval or disapproval. The actual and 13 necessary traveling expenses of nonresident members in 14 attending the annual meeting of the board may be audited by 15 the auditing committee thereof and paid by warrant on the 16 treasurer out of the general fund of the university.

The trustees of the University of Wyoming, through their president chairman, shall report to the governor as required by W.S. 9-2-1014 respecting the progress, condition and wants of the university and of each school or

1	department thereof, the course of study in each, the number
2	of professors and students, the nature, costs and results
3	of important investigations, and such other information as
4	they deem important or as may be required by any law of
5	this state, or of the United States. The secretary and
6	treasurer of the board of trustees shall prepare an
7	itemized report showing the receipts and disbursements for
8	the year, the appropriation resolution for that year, the
9	purposes for which the revenue was expended, and the amount
10	of revenue expended upon each school or department of work,
11	including the experiment station.

12 (a) Within thirty (30) days after the election 13 establishing the community college district, and on or about December 1 each year thereafter, the board shall meet 14 and organize by electing one (1) of its members as 15 16 president chairman, one (1) as treasurer, and one (1) as secretary. The president chairman shall preside at all 17 18 meetings of the board except that a temporary chairman may 19 be selected by the board in his absence. The secretary 20 shall keep the minutes and proceedings of all board 21 meetings and the treasurer shall receive all funds payable to the district and disburse them on the order of the 22

- 14 (e) After ascertaining the best terms upon, and the
- 15 lowest interest at which the bonds can be sold, the
- 16 community college district board shall cause the bonds to
- 17 be suitably printed or lithographed, with coupons, if any,
- 18 attached, and thereafter shall have the bonds consecutively
- 19 numbered and otherwise properly prepared and executed.
- 20 Bonds may be in such form as the board may direct but must
- 21 bear the signature of the president chairman of the
- 22 community college board of trustees, be countersigned by
- 23 the secretary of the board, bear the district seal and be

countersigned by the county treasurer. Bond coupons, if 1 2 any, must be signed by the president chairman and secretary 3 of the board and by the county treasurer. The secretary of 4 the community college board shall endorse a certificate upon every bond that it is issued pursuant to law and is 5 within the debt limit of the issuer. Bonds shall be 6 registered by the county treasurer in a public book 7 8 provided for that purpose stating the number, date, amount, 9 time and place of payment, rate of interest, number of 10 coupons attached, if any, for each bond so entered and any 11 other proper description thereof for future identification.
