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- 11 9-1-613. Division agents; appointment;
- 12 qualifications; continuing education; appointment of
- 13 persons with specific skills.

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1 (d) The director may appoint as agents persons

2 possessing specific skills in the area of criminal

3 investigation including livestock investigations.

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## 5 11-20-408. Examination of agency records; report.

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7 (b) The board shall adopt an annual fiscal year

8 budget for the brand registration and inspection program.

9 The budget shall include any deficit amount from the prior

10 year and may include an operating reserve not to exceed one

11 (1) year for that portion of the program to be funded by

12 user fees. Based on the budget adopted under this

13 subsection, the board shall set the user fees for all

14 activities under the program at no less than the minimum

15 fees provided for in this chapter. Each fee may be

16 adjusted not more than one (1) time per fiscal year and by

17 not more than twenty percent (20%) twenty-five percent

18 (25%) in any one (1) fiscal year. The board shall report

19 annually by November 1 to the joint agriculture, state and

20 public lands and water resources interim committee with

21 respect to the budget adopted and fees set under this
