- 14 (a) As used in this article the following definitions

1 2 (ii) "Continuing Contract Teacher": 3 4 (A) Any initial contract teacher employed 5 by a school district before July 1, 2017, who has been employed by the same school district in the state of 6 Wyoming for a period of three (3) consecutive school years, 7 8 has had his contract renewed for a fourth consecutive 9 school year and, beginning school year 2019-2020 and each 10 school year thereafter, has performed satisfactorily on performance evaluations implemented by the district under 11 12 W.S. 21-3-110(a) (xvii) during this period of time; or 13 14 (B) Any initial contract teacher employed 15 on or after July 1, 2017, who has been granted continuing 16 contract status at the discretion of the employing school district and, beginning school year 2019-2020 and each 17 18 school year thereafter, has performed satisfactorily on 19 performance evaluations implemented by the district under 20 W.S. 21-3-110(a)(xvii) during this period of time. Under 21 this subparagraph, length of service as required under 22 subparagraph (A) of this paragraph shall not be a

prerequisite for a school district in granting continuing 1 2 contract teacher status; or 3 4 (B)(C) A teacher who has achieved continuing contract status in one (1) district, and who 5 without lapse of time has taught two (2) consecutive school 6 years and has had his contract renewed for a third 7 8 consecutive school year by the employing school district, and, beginning school year 2019-2020 and each school year 9 thereafter, has performed satisfactorily on performance 10 11 evaluations conducted by both districts under W.S. 21-3-110(a)(xvii) during this period of time. 12 13 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2017. 15
