As 1 2 used in this Election Code: 3 4 (xxiii) "Poll list" is the list of registered 5 voters as compiled by the clerk for use by election judges at the polls. The poll list shall: 6 7 8 (F) Provide for the notation of: 9 10 (IV) For general elections, electors 11 who change political party affiliation at the polls. 12 13 22-5-212. When declaration of party affiliation 14 required. 15 16 An elector requesting a major party ballot must declare his 17 party affiliation, or sign an application for change of affiliation, in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214, before he may 18 19 receive a party ballot. An elector may vote only the 20 nonpartisan ballot and if so, is not required to declare his party affiliation. Requesting a partisan primary election 21

ballot constitutes a declaration of party affiliation. A

change in declaration of party affiliation shall conform to

W.S. 22-5-214 and be entered on the poll list by the election 1 2 judge. 3 4 22-5-214. Change in party affiliation. 5 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, an 6 elector may change his party affiliation by completing an 7 8 application signed before a notarial officer or election 9 official, and filing it with the county clerk not less than 10 fourteen (14) days before the primary election or at the polls 11 on the day of the primary or general election, or when 12 requesting an absentee ballot. 13 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this 14 15 section, no elector may change party affiliation between the 16 period of time beginning two (2) weeks before the first day 17 absentee ballots may be distributed under W.S. 22-9-107 through the day of the primary election. 18 19 20 (c) Upon request by a state party chairman, the 21 secretary of state shall authorize electors to change party affiliation to the state party chairman's political party 22 during the period of time specified in subsection (b) of this 23
