Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
Constitution, Article 1, by creating a new Section 40 is
proposed for submission to the electors of the State of

- 1 rejection to become valid as a part of the Constitution if
- 2 ratified by a majority of the electors at the election:

- 4 Article 1, Section 40. Right of privacy; right to
- 5 know.

- 7 The right of individual privacy is essential to the well-
- 8 being of a free society and shall not be infringed without
- 9 the showing of a compelling state interest. Nothing in
- 10 this section shall be construed to deprive a person of any
- 11 right provided by law to examine documents or to observe
- 12 the deliberations of any agency or political subdivision of
- 13 the state, except in cases in which the demand of
- 14 individual privacy clearly exceeds the merits of public
- 15 disclosure.

- 17 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- 18 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

2 individual privacy which shall not be construed to deprive
