A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution to declare that all wildlife is the property
3 of the state.

5 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
6 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
7 *separately, concurring therein:*

9 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
10 Constitution by creating Article 1, Section 38 is proposed
11 for submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at
12 the next general election for approval or rejection to
13 become valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
14 majority of the electors at the election:

1 **Article 1, Section 38. Wildlife is property of the**
2 **state.**

3

4 All wildlife in Wyoming is the property of the state. The
5 state shall provide an adequate and flexible system for
6 control, propagation, management, protection and regulation
7 of all Wyoming wildlife. The determination and
8 establishment of wildlife populations and their
9 distribution shall be the responsibility of the state.

10

11 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
12 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

13

14 The adoption of this amendment would declare that all
15 wildlife in Wyoming is the property of the state, that the
16 state shall provide an adequate and flexible system for
17 control, propagation, management, protection and regulation
18 of all Wyoming wildlife; and that the determination and
19 establishment of wildlife populations and their
20 distribution shall be the responsibility of the state.
