- 13 majority of the electors at the election:

1 Article 7, Section 9. Taxation for schools.

3 (a) The legislature shall make such further provision 4 by taxation or otherwise, as with the income arising from the general school fund will create and maintain a thorough 5 and efficient system of public schools, adequate to the 6 proper instruction of all youth of the state, between the 7 8 ages of six and twenty-one years, free of charge; and in 9 view of such provision so made, the legislature shall 10 require that every child of sufficient physical and mental 11 ability shall attend a public school during the period 12 between six and eighteen years for a time equivalent to 13 three years, unless educated by other means.

(b) Any finance system for public schools adopted by the legislature shall be presumed to be valid and a rational basis standard of review shall be employed in any judicial proceeding to review the constitutionality of the

school finance system. 19
